Mossie Elaine Parker Ammons, 62, of Charlotte, passed away peacefully at home on April 8, 2026, surrounded by the love of her family. Born in Monroe, North Carolina, on August 9, 1963, she was the daughter of Ell and Elizabeth Hooks Parker. She grew up in Monroe, where her love for the outdoors first took root, and as a teenager she made her way to the Charlotte area, which she would call home for the rest of her life.

Mossie was a woman whose heart was as open as her door. A longtime member of Faith Baptist Church, she lived out her faith through quiet kindness, generosity, and a natural gift for caring for others. She was a nanny and “grandma” not only to her own family but to countless children in the community—many of whom grew up knowing her as a steady, loving presence in their lives. Her warmth, patience, and gentle humor made her a second mother to more people than she ever realized.

She is survived by her sons: Brian Parker (wife Jennifer) of Statesville, and their children Braxton, Jaxon, and Alexandria; and Christopher Parker of Charlotte, and his daughter Destiny. She is also survived by her brother, William Parker of Gastonia, along with numerous nieces, nephews, extended family members, and friends who loved her dearly. She was preceded in death by her brother, Buddy Parker.

Mossie's family has entrusted the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home with the privilege of caring for her and for them. Services will be held on Monday, April 13, at Faith Baptist Church. Visitation will begin at 10 AM, followed by a service led by Pastor Rick Baker at 11 AM.
