Neil Dudley Ewing Jr, 52, of Charlotte, died unexpectedly at his home July 29, 2018.

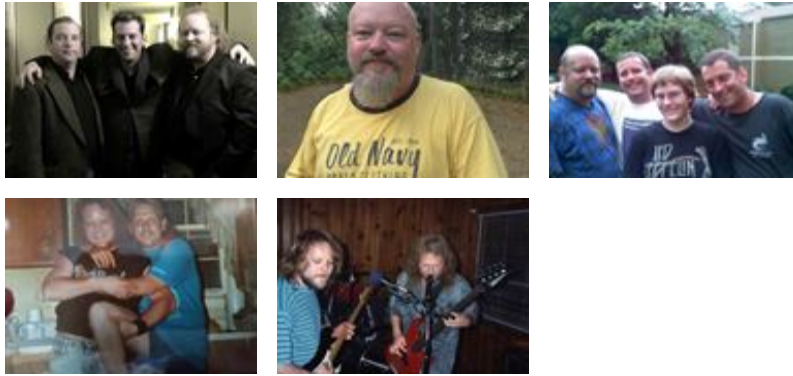

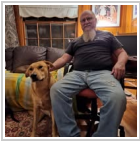
