Ralph Kelsey Tucker, 85, of Charlotte, North Carolina, went to be with The Lord on Saturday, January 29, 2022 at Atrium Health University in Charlotte. Mr. Tucker leaves behind his beloved wife Mila Carrasquel Tucker of Charlotte, former wife Fannie Artino Tucker of Boca Raton, Florida, daughter Tammy Tucker Katsikis and husband of Pompano Beach Florida, son Tim Tucker of Cincinnati, Ohio, and two grandchildren Zachary and Jakob.
