



Fr Richard Bakley

April 14, 1944 - May 9, 2021

The Venerable Richard E Bakley, 77, resident of Locust NC passed into the arms of Our Lord Jesus Christ Sunday May ninth, 2021.

Fr. Richard was born in Camden NJ to George and Edna Bakley. He received his degree in Horticulture from Delaware Valley University in 1966, and joined the Marine Corps from which he retired honorably as a Corporal. He was ordained to the Priesthood in 1984 and was the Rector of All Saints Anglican Church in Mills River NC for nine years and the Rector of St. Michael's Anglican Church in Matthews NC for 23 years.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years Patricia, son Thomas, daughter Ellen, son in law André, grandson Atticus, granddaughter Adelaide, and sister Helen. The Requiem Mass will be celebrated on Monday, May seventeenth at 2:00pm at St. Michael's Anglican Church in Matthews NC. There will be a reception in the parish hall following the service.
