



## Richard Edward Wilson

Richard Edward Wilson, 79, of Midland, died May 16, 2024. Through the blessing of hospice, he was able to be at home surrounded by family.

Richard was born in Mecklenburg County on July 26, 1944, the son of Byrd and Cora Lee Hefner Wilson. He grew up in the Wilgrove area near where the airport used to be. Rich attended Clear Creek Elementary and then Bain Academy. After school, he went into the HVAC business, working his way up to Supervisor.
