Robert Alan Tober, 66 of Charlotte, died Saturday, July 20, 2013.

Robert was born in Buffalo, New York, on August 13, 1946, the son of Elmer and Joan Balmas Tober. In answer to his country's call to service, Robert faithfully served in the United States Navy and was enlisted on April 12, 1966. There, he received the training to serve as Radioman where his last duty assignment was NAVCOMMSTA, Okinawa. On January 13, 1970, he was honorably discharged. Robert returned to New York and went to work as a supervisor for General Motors Corporation until moving to Charlotte in the early 1990's. In Charlotte, Robert drove routes for Princess Dry Cleaning.

Robert was an honest, hardworking man who lived a simple "what you see is what you get" life. He enjoyed networking, movies, and collecting guns and knives. With service to his country during the Vietnam War, he was a proud member of the Vietnam Veterans Chapter in Charlotte. Most of all, Robert loved his family and friends, and he will be sadly missed by all who knew him.

Robert is survived by his wife, Patricia; a son, Travis Tober of Austin, Texas; and two daughters: Deanna (and husband Douglas) Moore of Monroe, NC, and Lydia Massey of Charlotte; two granddaughters: Rae and Ashley Moore; a sister, Mary Joan (husband Jerry) Walters; and his four legged canine companion, Leila. Robert is further survived by numerous other relatives and

friends. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Don Tober.
