Roscoe “Ross” Carter, 63, of Matthews, NC, died unexpectedly on Sunday, February 2, 2019, doing one of the many things he loved to do, riding his motorcycle.

Roscoe was born in Lima, Ohio, on June 13, 1955, one of 13 children born to William and Mildred Carter. He grew up in Lima then moved to Florida where his son, Jesse, was born. On the flip of a quarter, he and his family moved to Charlotte, where his daughter, Bobbi-June, was born. 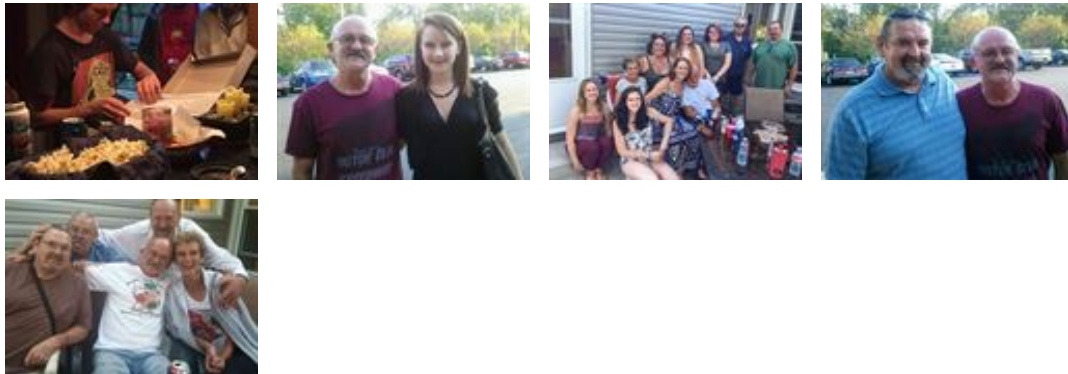
