Sadie Luearl Triplett, 95, of Matthews, entered into the heavenly kingdom on Monday, January 16, 2017.

Born in Winston County, Mississippi, on May 25, 1921, Sadie was the oldest daughter and second oldest child born to Abraham Lincoln Triplett and Bertha Geneta Lewis. 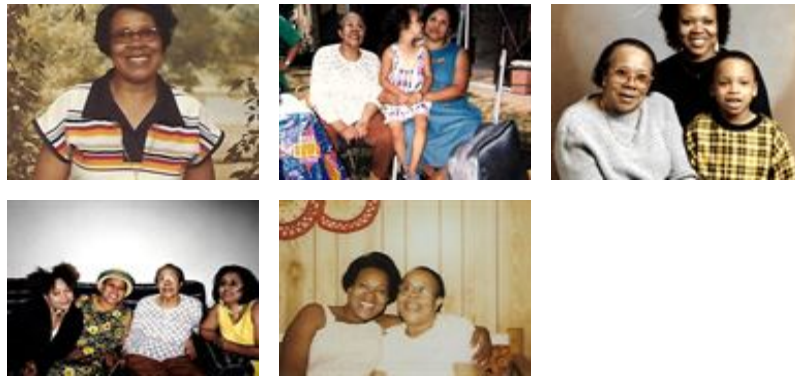
