Samuel Magliocca, age 88, passed away on March 10, 2024 at Novant Health Medical Center in Matthews, NC. He was born on September 23, 1935, in McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania to Simeon and Natalina Carricata Magliocca. Sam graduated from Hillsborough High School, Tampa, Florida.

Sam was employed by Sears, Roebuck and Co while in high school. After graduating high school in 1953, Sam started his 53-year career in the building industry. He was employed by Air Control Products, which was later renamed Keller Building Products of Charlotte, Inc. He moved from Tampa to Birmingham to Charlotte, NC with the company. He worked his way up starting out as a warehouse manager to becoming the owner and president in May 1991. Sam was exceptionally proud of the work his company did providing and installing windows, doors, cabinets, cabinet tops and flooring for residential homes in both NC and SC.
