Mrs. Sarah Louise Lowry, 89, of Matthews, past away surrounded by her loving family, Friday, March 19, 2021, at the Novant Medical Center, Matthews Campus.

Sarah was born in Montgomery, Alabama, on December 3, 1931, the daughter of Leon and Lessie Woodruff Richardson. She grew up there and after school, attended Pembroke State University from which she graduated in 1960. Sarah later attained her Master's Degree in Education and she was a well known and loved teacher for Union County Public Schools for 30 years before her retirement. Many students had her for English, History and Journalism. A few also had her for her other role, administrator of the in-school detention and suspension program. Sarah could be very creative in designing consequences and punishments for students at Parkwood High School, and she certainly won't be soon forgotten.

One day while at First Baptist Church in Montgomery, Alabama, she met a handsome young man in his Air Force uniform, a gentleman by the name of Earl Lowry. They began dating and on May 27, 1954, they married. Earl and Sarah were preparing to celebrate their 67th anniversary this year.

When not working, she enjoyed gardening and loved flowers. While most have 8 fingers and 2 thumbs, Sarah seemed to have 10 green thumbs. Most of all, she loved the time spent with family and friends. Blessed with the talents to teach, she also taught Sunday School at East Baptist Church.
