Sharron Monique Coston, 54, of Matthews, died Saturday, April 2, 2022, at Novant Presbyterian Hospital under the care of the Harris Hospice unit.

Sharron was born in Lumpkin, Georgia, on November 7, 1967, the daughter of Bernice Smith, Jesse Macon and Arthur McCarthy. At an early age, her family moved to London, England, and then to Rapid City, South Dakota and then on to Fort Lee, Virginia. She graduated from Prince George High School and went on to attend Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU). Sharron received her Bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a minor in Marketing from VCU. She went on to work for Nations Bank, now Bank of America. She ultimately became a Compliance Manager at Donnelley Financial Services where she had been until her passing.
