Shaun is survived by his mother, Karen, of Charlotte; his sister, Melissa Brown of Charlotte; his brother Bobby (wife Jennifer) Ryan of Charlotte; his aunt, Laurie (husband Jimmy) Ryan of New Jersey and their children Michael, Connor and Danny; his nieces, Channing Ryan and Dasia Brown; and his nephews: Devon Ryan, Beckham Ryan, Tristin Brown, Daeton Brown and Ryder Brown.
