



## Vernon Myles Bynoe

November 18, 1969 - January 21, 2021

Vernon Myles Bynoe, 51, of Charlotte, died Thursday, January 21, 2021. Vernon was born in Buffalo, NY, on November 18, 1969, the son of Edna Francis Fleming-Bynoe and Winston Arden Bynoe. He was raised in Charlotte and graduated from South Mecklenburg High School in 1987. Vernon went on to attend Vanderbilt University before going to work for UPS. In 2015, he met Ms. Ana Hendrix and they were married in 2018. Blessed with a talent to use his hands, he enjoyed drawing and sketching, especially nature subjects. Vernon was also an avid jazz music lover. Most of all, Vernon loved the time spent with family and friends.

Vernon is survived by his wife, Ana; their four legged canine fur baby, Chika; Ana's children: Daniel and LiyAna; his father, Winston (wife Patricia) Bynoe of Greensboro, NC; a brother Vaughn Bynoe of Front Royal, Virginia; a brother Ben (wife Sherry) Bynoe of Charlotte; and a sister, Vivian Bynoe of Savannah, Georgia. He is further survived by numerous nieces, nephews, aunts, and uncles spanning from New York to Florida as well as numerous other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his mother.

Vernon's family has given the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home the privilege of caring for him and for them. Vernon will lie in state on Tuesday, January 26, at the funeral home, from 10 am until 8 pm. Due to COVID, social distancing rules are in effect and masks are mandatory. 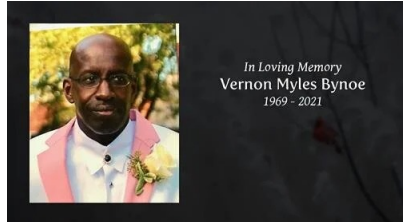
