Walter S. Dukes age 87 of Charlotte, NC went to be with his Lord on February 2, 2018 surrounded by his family. He was born on September 18, 1930 in St. George, SC. Walter graduated from St. George High School, then served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. After his service he worked in military and industrial electronics, and in time retired from GE and Bendix.
