



## Wanda Kaye Privette

April 17, 1948 - May 22, 2016

Wanda Kaye Privette, 68, a lifelong resident of Mint Hill, died Sunday, May 22, 2016, at the Levine and Dickson Hospice House at Southminster in Pineville.

Kaye was born at Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte on April 17, 1948, the daughter of John Merritt and Janie Barker Earp. She was a member of the first graduating class of Independence High School, the Class of 1967. She worked for a time in the Cafeteria at Bain Elementary School in Mint Hill. She most loved the time spent with family and friends and she will be missed by all who knew her.

Kaye is survived by her husband, Michael of Mint Hill; a sister, Barbara Atkinson of St. Cloud, Florida; a brother, Frank Earp of Huntersville; and a brother, Ted Earp of Goldsboro. She is further survived by numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, five siblings: Marie Earp, L.M. Earp, W.H. Earp, Bobbie J. Earp, and Betty Jean Earp; and four half-siblings: Troy, Walt, J.Z. and Marie.
