William "Bill" Edward Teague, 72, of Charlotte, passed away on January 24, 2016.

Bill was born on January 21, 1944, son of the late William Columbus Teague and Wanda Caroline Hopkins Teague. He attended Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools and graduated in 1962 in the first class from "The New Harding" High School. He attended Duke University for two years before joining the National Guard. Following an honorable discharge, he graduated from Western Carolina in 1967.

He is survived by his wife of 37 years, Lynn Elmore Teague; his daughter Heather Teague Lanier and her husband Ashley of Greensboro, NC; and a son Russell Teague and his wife Heather of Holly Springs, NC. He is further survived by his grandchildren: Emma Lanier, Carden Teague, Kessler Teague and Brylen Teague; and numerous other relatives and friends.

Bill worked for over 30 years as a computer consultant. After retiring, he went to work for several banks, most recently Fifth Third Bank in the mail department. He was a member of Hawthorne Lane United Methodist Church, 501 Hawthorne Lane, where a memorial service will be held January 30, 2016. Friends are welcome to call upon the family from 10 to 11 AM. At 11 AM, Dr. Thomas Steagald will lead all present in a Celebration of Life service.
