Williams Eduardo Marin Medina, 45, of Charlotte, tragically fell into and drowned at Mountain Island Lake while fishing on May 21, 2024.

Willy was born in Veracruz, Mexico, on Aug 3, 1978, the son of Augusto and Catalina Marin. He grew up there and then came to the Charlotte area in the early 2000's to join his family. Willy was a very hard-working man and he made friends wherever he went.

He enjoyed hiking, fishing, exploring nature and all the outdoors had to offer along with his son, Willy and many friends. His love of nature extended to voluntary cleanups with his nephews, who may or may not have "volunteered".

He made a point to spend time with his mother (and step-father) several times a week. There, he not only enjoyed delicious home cooked meals but also took part in lively conversation on current events, stories from work and life in general. His mother could count on his frequent text messages, sharing his love for her with warmth and sincerity.

Willy was always looking forward to going back to Mexico to spend time with his son, Eduardo and start the next chapter of his life in Mexico.

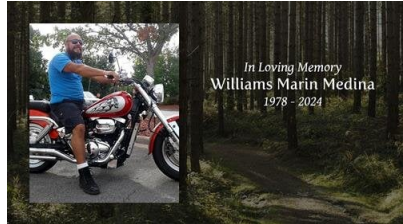
